



Australian Roundtable to Inform Development of IAASB and IESBA Work Plans for 2028-31

The International Auditing and Assurance Standards Board (IAASB) and the International Ethics Standards Board for Accountants (IESBA) are committed to co-ordinating strategies and Work Plans for 2028–31. The IAASB and IESBA are conducting a [joint survey](#) to inform the boards' strategic planning process.

The survey focuses on three principal areas:

- Strategic positioning for 2028–31, including how the boards should assess success by the end of the next strategy period;
- Key environmental trends shaping the future of audit, assurance, ethics, and independence, such as digital transformation, geopolitical and regulatory developments, sustainability expectations, and evolving business models of accounting firms; and
- Opportunities for joint or parallel action, where closer coordination between the IAASB and IESBA could enhance impact and effectiveness.

To inform our responses to the IAASB and IESBA survey, the Auditing and Assurance Standards Board (AUASB) and Accounting Professional & Ethical Standards Board (APESB) are holding a joint roundtable to hear from Australian stakeholders. The roundtable details are:
